I am requesting funding for the Kilohana Community Center Energy Efficiency and Resiliency Upgrade in Fiscal Year 2025. The intended recipient is the County of Maui located at 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Hawai'i 96793.

Requested funds would be used to build resiliency in Kilohana Recreation Center. Kamehameha V Highway runs along the southern coast of Moloka'i and is prone to flooding during rainstorms, king tides, and other extreme weather events. For the community of Ualapu'e and those living along the highway to the East, the Kilohana Community Center is one of the few public gathering areas on the east side of Moloka'i.
