I am requesting funding for the **Lānaʻi Affordable Housing Project** in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the **County of Maui**, located at **200 South High Street, Wailuku, Hawaiʻi 96793**.

The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it would support the construction of more than 372 housing units for residents on the Island of Lānaʻi. The project will consist of 199 affordable housing lots and 173 affordable multi-family rental and for-sale units to provide workforce housing and help relieve stress on the current housing supply in Maui and Lānaʻi. This funding would specifically enable the County of Maui to complete water and sewer networks for the lots.

The project has a Federal nexus because it is consistent with the purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. §5305(a)(2).
