I am requesting funding for the **Kilauea Town Housing Expansion Project** in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the **County of Kaua'i** located at **4444 Rice Street**, **Suite 330**, **Lihu'e**, **Hawai'i** 96766.

The requested project will fund critical site preparation for Phase I of the Kilauea Town Expansion on Kaua'i's North Shore, including clearing, grubbing, and mass grading. This work represents about 15 percent of Phase I construction costs and is based on similar housing development projects by the County. When completed, the project will deliver approximately 350 affordable homes on 50 acres, addressing a severe housing shortage. Developed with strong community input, the project will also include parks, commercial space, and infrastructure upgrades, all designed to preserve the town's historic character while supporting long-term growth.

The project has a Federal nexus because it is consistent with the purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. §5305(a)(2).
