I am requesting funding for the **Maui Health Facilities Repair and Modernization** project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is **Maui Health System** located at **100 Keokea Place, Kula, HI 96790**.

The funding would be used to repair facility and equipment damage caused by catastrophic flooding, restore long-term and acute care services, and strengthen resilience at Kula Hospital, Lanai Community Hospital and Maui Memorial Medical Center to better withstand future emergencies. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it ensures continued access to essential healthcare, preserves continuity of care for Upcountry and island-wide residents, and supports the broader effort to restore and modernize the Maui Health system.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
