Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the **Maui Homeless Services Campus Renovation** project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the **County of Maui** located at **200 S. High Street, Wailuku, HI 96793**.

The requested funding would support renovation of Building 3 at the Ka Hale A Ke Ola (KHAKO) campus in Wailuku, Maui, preserving eight transitional housing units that serve approximately 24 households annually. These units provide critical stability, supportive services, and time for individuals and families exiting homelessness to secure permanent housing. The project will upgrade major building systems, renovate interiors to meet current codes and HUD standards, and ensure safe transitions from emergency shelter. This investment maintains essential transitional housing capacity, reduces returns to emergency shelter, and strengthens long-term housing stability in Maui.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
