A BILL

To provide for the termination of tariffs with respect to certain countries and other jurisdictions under Executive Orders 14257 and 14326.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Indo-Pacific Partner
5 and Ally Tariff Repeal Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

7 It is the sense of Congress that—

1 (1) the United States should collaborate with
2 Indo-Pacific allies and partners to establish a collec-
3 tive defense against the Chinese Communist Party's
4 nonmarket practices and coercive economic, military,
5 and gray-zone actions;

6 (2) imposing tariffs on Indo-Pacific allies and
7 partners undermines that goal while inflicting costs
8 on U.S. consumers and businesses; and

9 (3) therefore, the tariffs established by Execu-
10 tive Order 14257 (90 Fed. Reg. 15041) and Execu-
11 tive Order 14326 (90 Fed. Reg. 37963) on Indo-Pa-
12 cific partners and allies are counterproductive to
13 America's security and economic needs and should
14 be repealed.

15 **SEC. 3. TERMINATION OF TARIFFS WITH RESPECT TO CER-**
16 **TAIN COUNTRIES AND JURISDICTIONS**
17 **UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDERS 14257 AND 14326.**

18 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective on the date of the enact-
19 ment of this Act, any tariff established pursuant to Execu-
20 tive Order 14257 (90 Fed. Reg. 15041) or Executive
21 Order 14326 (90 Fed. Reg. 37963) with respect to the
22 countries and other jurisdictions described in subsection
23 (b) shall cease to have force or effect.
