

# ALL PEOPLE IN THIS COUNTRY HAVE RIGHTS.

## KNOW YOURS.

### DON'T:

- Lie or show false documents
- Claim U.S. citizenship if you are not
- Run, panic, resist, or shout
- Put your hands in your pockets (keep them visible)

### IF ICE APPROACHES YOU...

- Ask: "Am I under arrest or free to leave?"
- If not free to leave, stay where you are.
- You do not have to answer questions or show documents.
- Say: "I choose to remain silent."
- Do Not Provide False Information.

### IF YOU ARE ARRESTED...

- You have the right to ask for an attorney. Request a list of pro bono lawyers if needed.
- Do not sign anything before speaking to a lawyer or fully understanding it. You may waive rights and risk deportation.

### YOU CAN...

- Remain Silent. You do not have to share your birthplace, immigration status, or how you entered the U.S.
- Ask for a Lawyer.
- Refuse Consent to a Search.
- Refuse to Sign Anything until you speak to an attorney and understand it.
- Document the Interaction. Ask someone to record. Write down what happened.

### IF ICE COMES TO YOUR HOME

- Do NOT open the door unless they have a valid search warrant signed by a judge.
- An ICE warrant is NOT a search warrant and does not allow entry without your consent.
- Ask them to slide the warrant under the door or show it through a window.
- It must have your correct name and address and be signed by a judge.
- If you remain silent, say: "I choose to remain silent."

### STAY PREPARED.

- Our office can contact federal agencies for case updates or information. We cannot give legal advice, change decisions, or guarantee outcomes. Inquiries may clarify delays or next steps. Response times vary.
- Know your elected federal officials. Keep a signed DHS/ICE Privacy Waiver in a safe place in case we need to contact agencies for you.
- Memorize at least one emergency contact number.
- Consult a lawyer before anything happens.
- Keep copies of important documents; store originals in a safe place.
